How to Apply:

To join the Allergy College Programme, submit your application by **28 March 2025** to **juniormembers@eaaci.org** with the subject line: "**Allergy College 2025 Application**". Applications should include:

1. Name of mentor (if applicable)
2. Your preference to attend EAACI Congress 2025 in-person or online
3. A one-page motivation letter
4. A CV (maximum two pages)
5. Title and summary of the proposed research project (maximum 500 words)

If seeking a mentor, outline the research you wish to pursue.

Eligibility:

To apply, both the student and mentor must be EAACI members. Junior membership is free for those under 40 and can be easily completed online at EAACI Membership.
