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applies to abstracts with identifiable patient information.

For the publication of an abstract that contains identifiable information about patients it is necessary that patients have given consent for the research to be published. For all abstracts that include identifiable patient details (e.g. gender, age, illness, location) or images, written informed consent for the publication of these must be obtained from the patient (or their parent or legal guardian).

By agreeing to these terms, I confirm that:

- a. Written informed consent for publication of these clinical details and/or clinical images included in my abstract presentation was obtained from the patient/parent/guardian/relative of the patient (please include an explanatory statement in your abstract text).
- b. The final decision on whether consent to publish is required or not lies with EAACI.

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
