Strategic Forum in Brussels | 16 April 2026

- EAACI brought together **experts and policymakers** to address the growing burden of allergy in Europe

As independent auditor, we have examined the financial statements (balance sheet, income statement and notes) of Academy of Allergy and Clinical Immunology for the financial year ended on December 31, 2025. The audit of the prior year financial statements, which has been conducted in accordance with auditing standards promulgated by the Swiss profession, was performed by another auditor, who expressed an unmodified examination conclusion on those financial statements on 11 May 2025.

These financial statements are the responsibility of the Executive Committee. Our responsibility is to perform a limited statutory examination on these financial statements. We confirm that we meet the licensing and independence requirements as stipulated by Swiss law.

We conducted our examination in accordance with the Swiss Standard on the Limited Statutory Examination. This standard requires that we plan and perform a limited statutory examination to identify material misstatements in the financial statements. A limited statutory examination consists primarily of inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures as well as detailed tests of company documents as considered necessary in the circumstances. However, the testing of operational processes and the internal control system, as well as inquiries and further testing procedures to detect fraud or other legal violations, are not within the scope of this examination.

Based on our limited statutory examination, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the financial statements do not comply with Swiss law and the company's articles of incorporation.
